

**ORDINANCE 2069**

**AN ORDINANCE TO REQUIRE THE PLACEMENT OF HOUSE AND OR BUILDING NUMBERS.**

**Whereas**, all buildings and homes within the Village of Montpelier are assigned its respective number or numbers, and

**Whereas**, for purposes of the health and safety of the community, the owner, occupant or agent shall place or cause to be placed upon each house or building the number or numbers assigned to such structure.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Montpelier that:

Section 1: Effective Date of Numbers. The numbers assigned under the provisions of this Chapter shall be placed on such houses and buildings within thirty (30) days after such numbers are assigned.

Section 2: Cost and Size. The cost of numbers shall be borne by the property owner. The numbers used shall be not less than three (3) inches in height and shall be made of durable and clearly visible material.

Section 3: Placing of Numbers. The numbers shall be conspicuously placed immediately above or at the side of the proper door of each building or house so that the number can be seen plainly from the street line. Whenever more than one residence is located within the building or house, each entry shall be marked with the proper building and apartment number. Whenever any building or house is situated more than fifty feet from the street line, such numbers shall be placed near the walk, driveway or common entrance to such building or house, or upon a gate post, fencepost, tree or other appropriate place so as to be easily readable from the sidewalk. Proper door for buildings and houses located on corner lots shall mean the door that faces the street of the assigned number.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage.
